Accoya USA has constructed a new Accoya[®] wood production facility in Kingsport, Tennessee, USA, that recently started commercial production to serve the North America market. Share Logistics will support the company with all global inbound (raw material) flows, storage, in-factory logistics and outbound (finished product) flows.

"Appointing Share Logistics as our long-term strategic supply chain partner was a logical choice," explains Rod Graf, Managing Director of Accoya USA. "It already has a long-standing service relationship and track record with Accsys, and hence the team is very familiar with our products and the related processes. The wood production plant in Kingsport will replicate the successful design and technology of Accsys Technologies' production facility in the Netherlands, which has a capacity of 80,000m3. The Accoya USA facility will initially have an annual production capacity of ~43,000m3 (~18 million board feet) provided through two acetylation reactors, replicating Accsys' proven-successful design, technology and processes at their Arnhem site in the Netherlands. As with Accsys' Dutch facility, the Kingsport plant design incorporates equipment and space to enable future expansion through adding more acetylation reactors.
